## What's happening at Jamieson Place

### Welcome to Jamieson Place

We wish to welcome Persta Resources Inc. (27th floor) and STX Energy Canada Inc. (27th floor) to the building! We anticipate the building will be 100% occupied by July of this year.

### Winter Garden

As you may have noticed, we are completing a few repairs in the Winter Garden. Once the repairs are completed, there are a few upgrades planned for the infinity pool and bio wall that will take place over the next two months. We thank you for your cooperation and patience during construction.

### P1 Shower/Locker Rooms

The project has taken much longer than anticipated, but it will definitely be worth the wait! The P1 Shower/Locker Rooms will be open for

Jamieson Place tenants by April 1st. The Men's room is located on the north end of the core and the Women's is located on the south end. All building occupants have free access to these facilities in addition to the bike cage on P1. Complimentary towel service is also available in this facility.

## Recycling/Environmental News

### *New Recycling Initiatives*

In addition to the current Recycling Programs we have at Jamieson Place, we would like to introduce two new initiatives to increase our waste diversion...Paper Towel Recycling and Organic Recycling.

At the beginning of March, 2011, we will be placing a **Black** bin in all washrooms for "clean" paper towel recycling. The bin will be labeled **"PAPER TOWELS ONLY."** It will be located near the paper towel dispensers.

"Clean" paper towels mean paper towels that have only been used for drying water from your hands or the counters as well as paper towels you use when you touch door handles. Please discard all other waste in the regular garbage slot located below the paper towel dispenser holder. Signs will be posted to guide you through the program to ensure that items are being put in the proper bin.

Starting April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 we will be implementing an Organic

Recycling Program in Jamieson Place that will be available to those tenants who wish to participate.

We will provide a small **GREEN** bin in one kitchen, per floor. The bin will be labeled "Organics Recycling."

**At this time, will only be accepting coffee grounds and tea bags. This includes paper filters and staples from the tea bag tags.** The cleaning staff will empty the bin nightly, or as required.

### *Pop Bottle/Can Recycling*

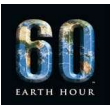
For 2011, we have partnered with Children's Wish Foundation of Alberta in connection with the building's pop bottle/can recycling program. All proceeds from the recycling of these bottles and cans are donated to the Children's Wish Foundation of Alberta. In conjunction with three other Bentall Kennedy managed downtown office buildings, we expect to donate approximately \$30,000 this year.

Established in 1984, Children's Wish is a national non-profit

organization dedicated to fulfilling a favorite wish for children diagnosed with life-threatening illnesses. Since its inception 25 years ago, Children's Wish has granted more than 16,000 wishes for children and their families and fulfills approximately 900 wishes annually -- granting nearly three wishes everyday - - each being an individual adventure, carefully structured to meet the needs of that particular child. The foundation has never refused a wish to an eligible child. Each wish is as unique as the child who makes it. A wish can range from a personal computer or a home theatre system, to travel or a meeting with a celebrity.

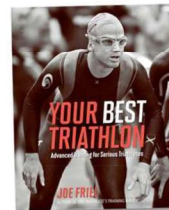

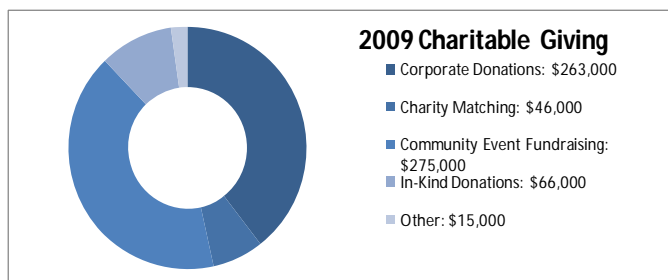
## BENTALL KENNEDY'S FIRST CORPORATE RESPONSIBILITY AND SUSTAINABILITY REPORT
